**Rules**

1. Each competitor has to complete an Entry Form and submit it to:

with payment of fees by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2010.
2. All Senior and Intermediate Members of the Club plus Junior members who are over 16 years of age or have been nominated or played for a Senior Tennis Team at any time are eligible to enter.
3. The unrestricted events ie; Ladies and Gents singles and doubles and mixed doubles will be the best of 3 tie break sets. The format of the restricted events will depend on entry numbers.
4. The number of seeded players/partnerships will be dependent on the number of entries and also depending on the size of entry for the events, which will be round-robin, with seeded players brought in to meet Section winners.
5. There is no restriction on the number of events that may be entered, however, **players should be aware of the time commitment involved. If several events are entered, players must be prepared to play matches in the different events entered on the same day/evening. Singles matches, however, should be played before any doubles matches scheduled for the same evening. Early organisation of matches should minimise problems in this area.**
6. Entrants cannot select their partners for the Ladies pot luck doubles or the Gents pot luck doubles.
7. The draw and Court booking sheets will be available on or before 9th August 2010.
8. **Mixed Doubles Entrants should be available for play during the first week of the Tournament.**
9. The semi-finals will be scheduled for specific times on the evenings of Wed. 1st Sept. Thursday 2nd Sept. and Friday 3rd Sept. The Finals will be held from 11.00am on Saturday 4th September 2010.
10. **Dates for completion of each round should be strictly adhered to. Results must be recorded on the draw sheet with score immediately after the match.**
11. **Top named players in the draw will be responsible for contacting their opponent to arrange the match.** This should be done as early as possible. The chances of a smooth running tournament are improved if the players start playing initial rounds promptly. If contact has not been made within 2 days of the completion date for the previous round the other player should consult the tennis committee and they will decide on a suitable course of action. Players may be scratched from the event under certain circumstances.
12. If possible 3 alternative times of play should be offered. Any difficulties with this or any other aspects of the event then the player should contact a member of the tennis committee.
13. In all matters relating to the Club Championships the decision of the Tennis Committee will be final.
