<u>Rules</u>

- Each competitor must complete an Entry Form and submit it with full payment of entry fees by Sunday 28th July 2019.
- 2. All Senior and Intermediate Members of the Club plus Junior members who are over 16 years of age or have been nominated or played for a Senior Tennis Team at any time are eligible to enter. Day members wishing to play in the championships may "upgrade" their membership for the three week duration of the championships by paying £30 with their entry fees.
- **3.** The unrestricted events ie; Ladies and Gents singles and doubles and mixed doubles will be the best of 3 tie break sets. The format of the restricted events will depend on entry numbers.
- **4.** The number of seeded players/partnerships in each category will be dependent on the number of entries for the event. Likewise, depending on the size of entry for each event, they may be played as round-robin events initially, with seeded players brought in to meet Section winners.
- **5.** There is no restriction on the number of events players can enter, **however**, if several events are entered, players **must** be prepared to play matches in the different events entered on the same day/evening. Early organisation of matches should minimise problems in this area.
- **6. All finals** will be played on **finals day Sat 7th September** and **all competitors** entering the championships **must** be available to play on finals day; if entering multiple events competitors **must** be prepared to play in all finals they reach on finals day.
- **7.** Entrants cannot select their partners for the Pot Luck events.
- **8.** The draw awill be available on or around **7th August** and all competitors that can, are encouraged to organise and play matches **as soon as possible from this date**. The **"Clubspark" online booking system** is to be used for all court bookings.
- **9.** Dates for completion of each round **must** be strictly adhered to. Results must be recorded on the draw sheet with score immediately after the match.
- 10. Top named players in the draw are responsible for contacting their opponent to arrange the match; however all players involved should make attempts to contact each other.
- **11.** If possible 3 alternative times of play should be offered. Any difficulties with this or any other aspects of the event then the player should contact Gerry Black 07799603934
- **12.** In all matters relating to the Club Championships the decision of the Tennis Committee will be final.
